- This application form is used to make an application for a new industrial hemp licence (research & breeding).
- For the application to be considered, all sections of the application form must be completed.
- The applicant must be the individual who is nominated to be the Responsible Person for the licence.
- This application form cannot be used to apply for a general licence (complete Form A1 'Application for a New Industrial Hemp Licence (General Licence)').
- During assessment of the application further information may be requested from the applicant.
- Information provided in the application may be shared with other agencies including the New Zealand Police and the Ministry for Primary Industries.

#### **APPLICATION FEE**

- Research & Breeding licence: \$153.33.
- Medsafe will issue an invoice to the applicant for the application fee. Applicants are advised to pay the application fee on receipt of the invoice, with reference to the correct invoice number (this ensures that the application fee paid is correctly matched to the application).
- The application will not be processed until the application fee is received by Medsafe.

- This application form can be completed electronically using a pdf reader. The current version of Adobe Reader, available free of charge from the Adobe website (https://get.adobe.com/reader) is recommended.
