## Outbreak Response

- Contact tracing, focused on close household and early child contacts.
- The priority remains to maintain the scheduled vaccinations for 15 months and 4 years.
- MMR vaccine is being offered with the HPV vaccine programme (given to 12 to 13 year olds).
- A drop in immunisation clinic in Whangarei - 2 days a week.
- Opportunistic immunisation at B4school check.
- MMR given to non immune staff at hospital.

## Vaccine Updates

- 5531 vaccines administered to date in 2019
- estimate 5,875 needed to deliver priority groups, planned school-based catch ups, additional 5-12 year olds not reached through the school programmes and to meet the current demand for 13-29 year olds
- 4,650 allocated from 100,000 and had 1430 in stock as at 1 October 2019.
- DHB provided with updated stock allocation and have made plans accordingly.
