
National Measles Outbreak: Southern District Health Board – accurate as of 16 October 2019

Cases of measles reported in the past two

- Additional workforce has been brought on help to manage increased
- The priority remains to maintain the scheduled vaccinations at 15
- DHB currently considering targeted vaccination of under 14s as direct

- Transient Queenstown population, international workers who do not have easy access to vaccination records.
- Due to housing shortages in Queenstown, workers come in from
 - throughout the region with new cases reported in Wanaka, Oamaru

Immunisation Rate Trend at December: 2014 - 2018 **Children Fully Immunised at 24 Months**

- 10,563 vaccines administered to date in 2019.
- 1724 doses are needed for the DHB to maintain the schedule.
- The DHB has 1400 in stock as of 27 September 2019.
- The Ministry has allocated 4735 doses from 100,000 doses that is due
- The DHB has requested 420 for immediate outbreak response and
 - 3500 for ongoing outbreak control including 15-29 in Queenstown and
