

Leighton House Limited

The following summary has been accepted by the Ministry of Health as being an accurate reflection of the Partial Provisional Audit conducted against the Health and Disability Services Standards (NZS8134.1:2008; NZS8134.2:2008 and NZS8134.3:2008) on the audit date(s) specified.

General overview

Leighton House is a 56 bed rest home, which was occupied by 48 residents on the day of audit. A partial provisional audit was undertaken to assess the readiness of the service to provide hospital and medical level care in addition to rest home care. The operations manager was appointed to the position in August 2013. She is supported onsite by a clinical nurse manager who is a registered nurse. The facility is run under the management of Dementia Care NZ Limited (DCNZ). The audit identifies that the building is suitable for hospital and medical level care with 20 bedrooms, one of the three lounges and the dining room area able to accommodate hospital level residents and equipment. There are policies and processes and staffing appropriate for providing hospital level care. There are no improvements identified as required at this audit.
