Address problems with alcohol and other drugs for an additional pregnant mums and parents with children under 3 years of age

Reduce mental health issues, levels of family violence, and child abuse and neglect.

Primary intention: Reduce damage to unborn babies and increase the opportunity for babies to develop good attachment with caregiver/s and become thriving healthy and resilient children

Lower incidence of Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD) within the NZ population

Lower levels of other neurodevelopmental disorders with the NZ population

Parents with higher levels of functioning, more parenting skills and more resilience

Parents who have resolved their issues around alcohol and other drugs and are in a healthier place for any future pregnancies

Children who have good attachment with their parents/caregivers, are healthy, meet all developmental milestones and have good levels of resilience.

Significant flow on health sector savings, freeing up resources for meeting other health needs (ie not cashable savings).

Less incidences of family violence, child abuse and neglect resulting in less need for Police, Corrections and Oranga Tamariki services

Some flow on education sector savings through a decrease in the amount of extra educational
