Independent Panel Reviewing Pharmac: Release of Interim Report

Portfolio Health

On 17 November 2021, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee (SWC):

- noted that in March 2021, SWC noted the Minister of Health's intention to establish a ministerial committee under section 11 of the New Zealand Public Health and Disability Act 2000 to undertake a review of Pharmac (the Review) and agreed that an interim report be provided to the Minister of Health by 20 August 2021 with a final report due by 10 December 2021 [SWC-21-MIN-0006];
- **noted** the purpose of the Review was to ensure the public can have confidence in Pharmac and its role in the wider health system;
- noted that the Review's terms of reference encapsulated two issues;
 - 3.1 how well Pharmac performs against its current objectives and whether and how its performance against these could be improved;
 - 3.2 whether Pharmac's current objectives maximise its potential to improve health outcomes for all New Zealanders (with a particular emphasis on equity for Māori and Pacific peoples) as part of the wider health and disability system, and whether and how these should be changed;
- 4 **noted** the Minister of Health's intention to publicly release the Interim Report from the independent panel reviewing Pharmac (the panel) attached under SWC-21-SUB-0180;
- 5 **noted** that minor technical and editorial amendments and design work may be made to the Interim Report prior to its public release;
- 6 **noted** that the Chair of the panel will respond to stakeholder and media queries generated by the release of the Interim Report;
- 7 **noted** that the panel will now deliver its final report to the Minister of Health by 28 February 2022;

8 **invited** the Minister of Health to report back to SWC as soon as practicable after receiving the panel's final report.
