


# COVID-19

## Reporting Rapid Antigen Test Results


All supervised rapid antigen test results must be reported to the Ministry of Health. This six step guide outlines how to report results via ESR Eclair.

1




Login to ESR Eclair at [cdr.esr.cri.nz](https://cdr.esr.cri.nz) and enter verification code sent to your two factor authentication cell phone.


Click on Rapid Antigen Test in menu.

Search for the individual using their NHI, or last name and DOB.




Confirm the individual's information and select the correct entry from the list.

Record the individual's mobile phone number and verify the number if possible. Input information about symptoms if applicable.

Interpret and record the result according to the kit instructions. Input the result along with the supervising staff member's full name.
