New Zealand does not take instruction or direction from other states or countries as to our domestic health policy, or our response to international health emergencies such as COVID-19. The Ministry has not received such advice from other countries regarding New Zealand's COVID-19 Response.

The Ministry of Health has engaged with many countries regarding the global response to the pandemic, including through the World Health Organization. For your information, formal diplomatic exchange with other governments, in relation to third countries' COVID-19 experience, primarily sits within the preserve of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (MFAT).
