## Smokefree Environments and Regulated Products (Smoked Tobacco) Amendment Bill: Approval for Introduction

Portfolio Associate Health (Hon Dr Ayesha Verrall)

On 13 June 2022, the Cabinet Business Committee:

- noted that in December 2021, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee agreed to amend the Smokefree Environments and Regulated Products Act 1990 and the Customs and Excise Act 2018 [SWC-21-MIN-0192];
- 2 **noted** that the Smokefree Environments and Regulated Products (Smoked Tobacco) Amendment Bill (the Bill) holds a category 3 priority on the 2022 Legislation Programme (to be passed if possible in the year);
- noted that the Bill amends the Smokefree Environments and Regulated Products Act 1990 to further restrict access and availability of smoked tobacco products, and reduce their appeal and addictiveness;
- 4 **approved** the Bill for introduction [PCO 23444/3.13], subject to the final approval of the government caucus and sufficient support in the House of Representatives;
- 5 **agreed** that the Bill be introduced on 23 June 2022;
- 6 agreed that the government propose that the Bill be:
  - 6.1 referred to the Health Committee for consideration;
  - 6.2 enacted, if possible, in 2022.
