Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), which was transferred from Southern District Health Board to the Ministry of Health (the Ministry) on 23 June 2022, regarding the breach mentioned on page 92 of the Ministry's *Annual Report* on Drinking Water Quality (2020-2021). Each part of your request is responded to below.

"Whether any action has been, or is going to be, taken by the Ministry of Health for the abovementioned breach of the Health Act"

The local investigating officers have discussed this breach with the Dunedin City Council. It is unlikely that prosecution action would be taken for a one-off breach of section 69Z of the Health Act. The Council co-operated fully with the investigating officers throughout the incident. Please note, this does not necessarily reflect what the Ministry may do in the future.

"An explanation why no mention, acknowledgement, or reference to this breach was included in the Ministry of Health's "Review of health response into Waikouaiti water supply lead contamination", dated 31 March 2021"

The review of the health response predated the preparation and publication of the *Annual Report for Drinking Water Quality (2020-2021)*. The review of the health response was an independent review and was not conducted by the Ministry.
