Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), which was partially transferred from the Department of Internal Affairs to Manatū Hauora (the Ministry of Health) on 8 September 2022. You requested:

As PM are you aware that many NZ ers consider that the Vaccine campaign has been carried out without fully conclusive testing ?Indeed the statistics to date of death from the vaccine prove leathal risk exists .Specifically what testing data have you relied upon that is scientically verifiable using science not opinion ?
