Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) received by Manatū Hauora (the Ministry of Health) as a transfer from Te Whatu Ora (Health New Zealand) on 22 February 2023 for information regarding COVID-19. You requested:

"It has now been conclusively proven in the Cochrane study paper of 30-Jan-2023, https://www.cochrane.org/CD006207/ARI_do-physical-measures-such-hand-washing-or-wearing-masks-stop-or-slow-down-spread-respiratory-viruses, that masks do not stop the transmission of covid. Are you going to update this website because it is now giving incorrect / wrong advice"

Manatū Hauora notes the findings of the Cochrane study and will continue to monitor emerging international evidence regarding COVID-19 including evidence of mask efficacy. Our COVID-19 science news webpage is regularly updated as significant evidence is assessed and deemed of relevance to the current COVID-19 response. Please also note that mandates related to mask usage fall under Cabinet ruling, with Manatū Hauora providing evidence and recommendations when required.
