School of Rural Medicine: An Alternative Approach

Portfolios Education / Health

On 12 November 2018, following reference from the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee, Cabinet:

- **noted** that there is a shortage of doctors and other health professionals in rural areas, which results in decreased access to medical care in rural areas;
- **noted** that improving access to health services for rural communities will require multiple solutions;
- **noted** that the establishment of a School of Rural Medicine would only address some of the issues;
- **noted** that in September 2017, the previous government agreed in principle to establish a School of Rural Medicine [CAB-17-MIN-0464];
- 5 **rescinded** the decision referred to in paragraph 4 above;
- 6 **invited** the Minister of Health to report to SWC in early 2019 with an update on short-term actions, and more detail on the proposed actions and solutions to address the maldistribution of health professionals in rural areas and improve access to health services in these areas.
