Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Andrew Little

Portfolio Health

On 11 April 2022, Cabinet:

- authorised the absence of Hon Andrew Little from New Zealand from 20 May to 27 May 2022, to travel to:
 - 1.1 Geneva, Switzerland to attend the World Health Assembly to deliver New Zealand's national address and attend bilateral meetings;
 - 1.2 Dudley, the United Kingdom to meet with global experts in health locality planning;
- 2 **agreed** that he be accompanied by one member of staff from his office;
- approved the estimated expenditure of up to \$\frac{9(2)(f)(v)}{2}\$ for travel expenses of the Ministerial party as a charge to Vote: Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive Travel);
- 4 **agreed** that in his absence:
 - 4.1 Hon Peeni Henare act as Minister of Health;
 - 4.2 Hon Grant Robertson act as Minister Responsible for the GCSB and Minister Responsible for the NZSIS;
 - 4.3 Hon Willie Jackson act as Minister for Treaty of Waitangi Negotiations;
 - 4.4 Hon Kiri Allan act as Minister Responsible for Pike River Re-entry from 20 to 22 May 2022;
 - Hon David Parker act as Minister Responsible for Pike River Re-entry from 23 to 27 May 2022;
 - 4.6 Hon Poto Williams act as Lead Coordination Minister for the Government's Response to the Royal Commission's Report into the Terrorist Attack on the Christchurch Mosques;
- 5 **noted** that the House is not sitting during his absence.
