A breakdown of the estimated costs for the COVID-19 Tracer application is included in the table below. The total amount of \$6.425 million is the total estimated costs budgeted up to 30 June 2021, confirmed as at 31 December 2020.

Technology enablers (covers temporary surge capacity for support desk to monitor calls from the public in relation to the application)	\$1.668
Support resources (project management and IT architecture support for the Ministry in the development of the application)	\$1.676
Security	\$0.305
Total	\$6.425
