## Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) received by the Ministry of Health (the Ministry) on 30 December 2021 for information relating to COVID-19 travel exemptions. You specifically requested:

"In accordance with clause 105 of the COVID-19 Public Health Response (Protections Framework) Order 2021;

- How does a person or company make an application for exemption in accordance with clause 105? There does not appear to be a legislative pathway.
- How many applications for exemptions under clause 105 have been made?
- How many applications for exemptions under clause 105 have been granted?"

There is no formal application process for applying for an exemption under clause 105. However, several exemptions have been granted to people who have requested them. The following tables provide the number of applications made and granted under clause 105.
