Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) to Manatū Hauora (Ministry of Health) on 17 August 2022. You requested:

Is the Ministry looking at purchasing COVID-19 vaccine made by Moderna that targets two coronavirus variants (known as a "bivalent" vaccine)? If yes, please provide me with the following documents:

- 1) How many doses have been ordered?
- 2) Cost per dose?
- 3) Scientific studies used to support purchase?

Manatū Hauora does not have an existing agreement with Moderna for the supply of COVID-19 vaccines. The agreements that the Ministry holds are outlined here: www.health.govt.nz/covid-19-novel-coronavirus/covid-19-vaccines/covid-19-vaccines-available-new-zealand/covid-19-purchasing-vaccines.

Manatū Hauora continues to monitor the evidence and developments occurring in the vaccine landscape to ensure New Zealanders have timely access to the best protection from COVID-19. From 1 July 2022 any new COVID-19 vaccine purchases are managed by PHARMAC.
