Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) to Manatū Hauora (the Ministry of Health) on 17 October 2022 for:

"Why are you "strongly encouraging" participants of Flu Tracker to stop participating over summer."

FluTracking participants in New Zealand and Australia have been encouraged to take a break from tracking over the summer period. This is to reduce participation fatigue. By taking a short break from tracking, Manatū Hauora hopes this will give participants a chance to refresh then continue with FluTracking surveys when there is an increase in flu and COVID-19 cases. FluTracking has an option for participants to be "called back early" if there is a rise in flu and/or COVID-19 cases.
