Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) received by the Ministry of Health (the Ministry) on 19 February 2022 for information regarding COVID-19 vaccine exemptions. Your request is responded to in turn:

How many applications for Covid vaccination exemptions have been received by the panel?

How many of these have been approved, declined, or are under consideration?

As at 16 March 2022, 2465 applications for a Temporary Medical Exemption (TME) have been processed by the Ministry. Of these:

Of the 2465 applications for a TME that have been considered by the Temporary Medical Exemption Panel.

- 777 have been granted
- 813 have been declined.

An additional 621 applications have been returned as incomplete and have not been considered by the Temporary Medical Exemption Panel.

Are any of these for renewal of a previously granted exemption?

The Ministry does not have a record of this information and there is no requirement under the Act for an agency to create or compile information it does not hold. Therefore, this part of your request is refused under section 18(g)(i) of the Act as the information requested is not held by the Ministry and there are no grounds for believing it is held by another agency subject to the Act
