Health Practitioners Competence Assurance (Designation of Paramedic Services as Health Profession) Order 2019

Portfolio Health

On 15 October 2019, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- **noted** that on 3 April 2019, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee agreed that an Order in Council be made under the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003 to:
 - 1.1 designate the paramedic profession as a health profession;
 - 1.2 establish a new responsible authority, the Paramedic Council, to regulate the paramedic profession, with secretariat support provided by the Nursing Council of New Zealand;

- **noted** that the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance (Designation of Paramedic Services as Health Profession) Order 2019 gives effect to the above decision;
- authorised the submission to the Executive Council of the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance (Designation of Paramedic Services as Health Profession) Order 2019 [PCO 22276/4.0];
- 4 **noted** that the Order will come into force on 1 January 2020.
