## Continuation of Prohibition on Imports of High-power Laser Pointers

**Portfolio** 

Associate Health (Hon Julie Anne Genter)

On 25 September 2019, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee:

- noted that the Customs Import Prohibition (High-power Laser Pointers) Order 2017 (the Order) currently prohibits the import of high-power laser pointers, unless consent to do so has been granted by the Director-General of Health;
- 2 noted that the Order will expire on 29 February 2020;
- noted that the Order is part of an existing package of regulatory controls on such devices that also includes controls on the domestic supply, acquisition, and possession of highpower laser pointers;
- 4 **agreed** that continuing the import prohibition is in the public interest as it prohibits the unauthorised importation of high-power laser pointers and supports other domestic supply chain regulatory controls;
- agreed to continue with the import prohibition of high-power laser pointers, currently provided by the Order, by making a new Customs Import Prohibition (High-power Laser Pointers) Order under the Customs and Excise Act 2018;
- 6 **invited** the Minister of Customs to issue drafting instructions to the Parliamentary Counsel Office to draft an Order in Council to give effect to the continued prohibition on importation of high-power laser pointers.
