





# SITREP 18 NATIONAL MEASLES OUTBREAK 2019

Issued: 1500 hrs, 9 OCTOBER 2019

#### **National Situation**

- From 1 January 2019 to 9 October 2019 there have been 1731 confirmed cases of measles notified across New Zealand (as at 0830hrs 9 October) based on ESR reporting. This is an increase of 11 cases nationally since Executive Summary 27 provided on Tuesday 8 October.
- 2. Over the last two weeks (26 September to 9 October) 227 cases have been reported nationally. In the same period, there have been 162 new cases reported in the Auckland region, with most cases reported in Counties Manukau District Health Board (CMDHB) (90 cases). See *Appendix 1* for details.
- 3. As expected, most cases have been in unvaccinated people, or in those whose vaccination status is unknown.


Figure 1. Number of confirmed measles notifications by week, 1 January- 4 October 2019

- 4. Figures detailing weekly notifications of measles cases across New Zealand are included in *Appendix 2*. Figure 1 indicates that for the last four weeks the weekly number of measles notifications has decreased. However, it is not yet possible to determine if the outbreak has peaked. Numbers of cases continue to increase in some regions outside of Auckland, particularly Northland DHB and Southern DHB. Notifications and associated trends will continue to be closely monitored.

- 6. Figures detailing the vaccination status of confirmed measles cases in the week to 9 October 2019, by age group, for the Auckland region, Northland DHB, Waikato DHB, Bay of Plenty and Lakes DHBs and Southern DHB are included in Appendix 1.

### **Auckland Situation**

7. As at 0830hrs 9 October, there have been 1409 confirmed cases of measles in the Auckland region, which is an increase of 6 cases since Executive Summary 27 provided on Tuesday 8 October.

8. New cases are mainly occurring in South Auckland. In total, **944** cases have occurred in CMDHB (see *Appendix 1* for details).

# Auckland Region Response – Key Actions

#### Counties Manukau DHB

- 9. As at 8 October, **396** cases have been admitted to Middlemore Hospital since June 2019. Demand is easing but there have been some delays in admitting patients due to overall high occupancy rates and varying demand for isolation beds.
- 10. Additional vaccinations have been given through the outreach clinics in Counties Manukau to 6,464 people (to 7 October).

#### Other Regions' Response - Key Actions

#### **Northland DHB**

- 11. As at 0830hrs 9 October, there have been **72** cases of measles reported in Northland DHB since 1 January 2019.
- 12. The current increase in numbers in Northland is largely due to measles in unimmunised siblings of confirmed cases resulting in large numbers of cases within a household. In the three weeks to 2 October 2019, five families have had 16 cases of measles.
- 13. A drop-in immunisation clinic has been set up in Whangarei for two days per week and an immunisation clinic has been set up in Kaitaia.

#### Waikato DHB

14. As at 0830hrs 9 October, there have been 39 cases of measles in Waikato DHB. The majority of these cases are linked to the Auckland outbreak.

# Bay of Plenty and Lakes DHBs

- 15. As at 0830hrs 9 October, there have been 39 cases of measles in Bay of Plenty DHB, and 22 cases of measles in Lakes DHB. Toi Te Ora has scaled up operations to manage all cases and identified contacts. Bay of Plenty and Lakes DHB are supporting Toi Te Ora with appropriately skilled personnel to manage cases and carry out contact tracing.
- 16. In anticipation of the expected release of additional MMR vaccine, Toi Te Ora is reviewing MMR coverage gaps by age cohort and developing options for outbreak response activities.

#### Southern DHB

17. As at 0830hrs 9 October, there have been 62 confirmed cases of measles in Southern DHB. 32 of these cases have been reported in the last two weeks (see Appendix 1),

- mainly in Queenstown. The number of cases is increasing in this region, and cases are predominantly in the 18-40 year age group.
- 18. The Southern EOC has scaled up operations to manage all cases and identified contacts. Extra staff from outside of the region are supporting this response.

# Ministry of Health

- 19. Daily teleconferences continue to be held between the three Auckland DHBs and the NHCC.
- 20. Teleconferences are being held between Southern DHB and the NHCC three times a week.

#### Vaccine Stock and Distribution

- 21. The 100,000 doses have arrived in New Zealand and have completed Quality Assurance processes. The Ministry has planned the allocation of 100,000 doses of MMR vaccine to DHBs and will continue to work closely with all DHBs to determine their vaccine requirements for the delivery of the Childhood Immunisation Schedule and any outbreak response activities.
- 22. Up to 4 October, 193,604 MMR vaccinations have been given in New Zealand this year according to the National Immunisation Register. This is compared to 100,504 vaccinations given in the same time period in 2018.

## **Public Information Management / Media**

- 23. Media interest continues for the Ministry of Health, PHARMAC and DHBs. Media releases and responses should mirror the Ministry messaging to ensure national consistency and be reviewed by the NHCC team prior to release.
- 24. From 30 September to 6 October, 14% of all visits to the Ministry of Health website were related to measles. A total of 14,600 users were looking for measles information. Of these, 7,800 were from the Auckland region.
- 25. The National Telehealth Service (Healthline) continues to experience high call volumes, although call volumes were only slightly above forecast for the weekend. For the 24 hour period ended midnight 6 October, 1020 calls were answered by the Health Services frontline team, which is close to typical for this time of year. Counties Manukau, Waitemata, Auckland and Canterbury DHBs had the highest number of symptomatic callers.
- 26. PlunketLine report call volumes have decreased since early September and have now settled.






**Figure 2.** Number of confirmed measles cases by week and DHB for the last six months, 2019




**Figure 3:** Vaccination status of confirmed measles cases by age group – Auckland region to 9 October 2019




**Figure 4:** Vaccination status of confirmed measles cases by age group – Northland DHB to 9 October 2019
