NATIONAL MEASLES OUTBREAK 2019

Issued: 1500 hrs, 18 SEPTEMBER 2019

National Situation

- From 1 January 2019 to 18 September 2019 (as at 0830hrs) there have been 1348 confirmed cases of measles notified across New Zealand, based on ESR reporting. This is an increase of 21 cases nationally since Executive Summary 12 provided on Tuesday 17 September.
- Over the last two weeks (5 September to 18 September) 317 cases have been reported nationally. During this period, case numbers have continued to increase rapidly in the Auckland region (267 cases), with most cases reported in Counties Manukau District Health Board (CMDHB) (187 cases). See *Appendix 1* for details.
- Recent cases outside of the Auckland region have been linked to the Auckland outbreak, and are limited to single cases and small clusters, such as the Queenstown outbreak. Public Health Units (outside of the Auckland region) continue to manage these cases and their contacts promptly, in order to limit transmission.
- 4. As expected, most cases have been in unvaccinated people, or in those whose vaccination status is unknown. There have been no reported deaths associated with this outbreak.

Auckland Situation

- 6. As at 0830hrs 18 September, there have been **1120** confirmed cases of measles in this region, which is an increase of 12 cases in the Auckland region since Executive Summary 12 provided on Tuesday 17 September.
- 7. New cases are mainly occurring in South Auckland. In total **775** cases have occurred in CMDHB (see *Appendix 1* for details).

Auckland Region Response – Key Actions

Counties Manukau DHB

- 8. As at 13 September, 303 cases have been admitted to Middlemore Hospital since June 2019. This currently includes three children with measles, admitted to a paediatric isolation ward, and six children who are no longer infectious but remain in hospital.
- 9. The final day for opportunistic vaccinations in Middlemore Emergency Department will be Saturday 20 September.
- 10. The final day for Middlemore Hospital drop-in clinic is 23 September, extended from 19 September.
- 11. Community drop-in clinics have now been suspended until further notice.

12. Up to 15 September, 5,220 additional vaccinations have been given through the outreach clinics in Counties Manukau. Of these, 15.2% have been given to those identifying as Māori, and 23.6% to those identifying as Pacific.

Other Regions' Response – Key Actions

Northland DHB

13. Four cases of measles were reported in Northland on 17 September. These cases are in a family cluster and are related to Auckland exposure. A further two cases reported at 1030hrs today, 18 September, were reported in error and will be removed in the next report.

Bay of Plenty and Lakes DHBs

14. Bay of Plenty and Lakes DHBs continue to see cases of measles. As at 0830hrs 18 September, there have been 32 cases of measles notified in Bay of Plenty DHB, and 15 in Lakes DHB.

Southern DHB

- 15. As at 0830hrs 18 September 2019, there have been **24** confirmed cases of measles in Southern DHB. 16 of these cases have occurred in the last two weeks (see *Appendix 1*), mainly in Queenstown. The cases in Queenstown are linked to Auckland exposure.
- 16. On Tuesday 17 September Southern DHB issued an alert to the public of potential exposure to measles following confirmation of the disease in a person travelling through Otago and Southland while in the infectious period. Contact tracing protocols have been initiated in the region.
- 17. Southern DHB continues to provide situation reports to the National Health Coordination Centre (NHCC) on a regular basis.

Ministry of Health

18. Daily teleconferences continue to be held between the three Auckland DHBs and the NHCC.

Vaccine Stock and Distribution

- 19. The Ministry of Health has requested that DHBs provide a Single Point of Contact through which the distribution of MMR vaccine will be coordinated to their immunisation providers.
- 20. An order of 52,000 doses of MMR vaccine arrived in New Zealand on 16 September. The DHB Single Point of Contact will be able to order this stock from 19 September for their providers.

Public Information Management / Media

- 21. Media interest continues for the Ministry of Health, PHARMAC and DHBs. Media responses should mirror the Ministry messaging for national consistency. All agencies continue to focus on exploring ways to proactively push vaccination messages and health awareness.
- 22. A Health Advisory was sent on 17 September to the sector advising on vaccine stock, distribution, and the priority groups for vaccination.

Phone line

23. The National Telehealth Service (Healthline) continues to experience high call volumes, particularly on weekdays. Below is an update on activity for the 24-hour period ending midnight 17 September.



Figure 1. Cases of measles in New Zealand and the Auckland Region to 18 September 2019








Figure 3. Number of confirmed cases by week and DHB from March 2019 to week ending 13 September 2019
