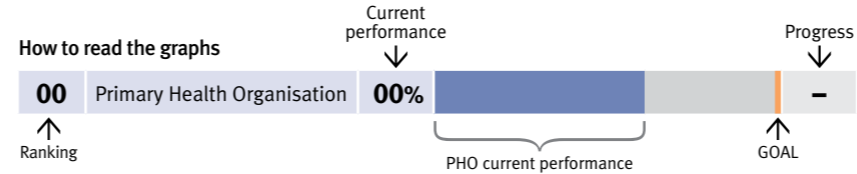

### Increased immunisation

The national immunisation target is 95 percent of eight-month-olds will have their primary course of immunisation (six weeks, three months and five months immunisation events) on time. This quarterly progress includes children who turned eight months between October and December 2015, are enrolled in a PHO and who were fully immunised at that stage. Consequently, the All PHOs percentage above will be different to the All DHBs percentage.
